

IN THIS PHOTO: Østfold Glassverk: The interior of a living room in „Naustalen“ was hand-made by the local glass-cutting master in the 19th century. The central motif of the room is a monumental round-headed bay window. It is the real highlight of the room. The floor of this old, cast iron door was painted with red, white and black stripes. The interior of this lavatory consisted of painted white tiles in the background. In the middle, a dark forest green mosaic was engraved with the motif of a royal coat of arms. In the kitchen of the greenhouse, glass was installed as ceiling, doors and walls. Four years after the glasswork was created, an artist of the time painted the scene. The painting shows one of the four original greenhouse windows that were already made from glass. Treatment of unresectable and metastatic colorectal cancer: are we making progress? A number of new approaches for treatment of advanced colorectal cancer have been developed in recent years. Phase II studies have shown that chemoradiation therapy results in improvement in the survival of patients with locally advanced rectal cancer. Despite the addition of oxaliplatin to the combination of 5-FU and leucovorin in combination with radiation therapy, the response rates for adjuvant and advanced disease remain low. A randomised trial demonstrated improved survival with the addition of an oral thymidylate synthase inhibitor to fluoropyrimidine therapy. Data regarding palliative treatment of metastatic colorectal cancer with 5-FU based chemotherapy are also encouraging. Data regarding the efficacy of capecitabine-based chemotherapy in the treatment of advanced colorectal cancer are inconclusive. New compounds including oxaliplatin, irinotecan and bevacizumab have been developed. The addition of bevacizumab to oxaliplatin-based chemotherapy has improved the response rates and survival of patients with metastatic colorectal cancer.
